Environmental Policy

The Cattle Yard aims to provide a high-quality working environment and actively seeks to reduce its environmental impact and enhance its natural environment. Our commitment is to;

- Reduce our consumption of resources and improve the efficiency of use of these resources.
- Focus on environmental enhancement when designing and managing our external areas and when designing, constructing and refurbishing buildings.
- Source and use environmentally friendly products, such as cleaning materials.
- Use local materials and suppliers where possible.
- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation.
- Actively research and identify best practice and new ideas to implement.
- Continually review performance.

Examples of current & recent initiatives include:

- The planting of fruit trees (pears, plums & damsons) to provide healthy snacks during the working day, along with the benefits for wildlife that come from the blossom, fruits & habitat creation.
- Outside seating & tables are being made from wood that has come from the site & the farm. These are being made by a local business based at the Cattle Yard, using wood from storm damaged trees.
- The construction of the café/shop at the Cattle Yard will reduce car miles (and encourage walking) for both people working at the Cattle Yard & residents of the village.
